The Champaign County Board of Health held a meeting on Tuesday, December 3, 2024, at the Champaign-Urbana Public Health District at 201 W. Kenyon Road, Champaign, IL. Dr. Krista Jones, President, called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM.

Roll Call

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Upon roll call, the following Board members were found to be present: Dr. Krista Jones, President, Mr. David Thies, Vice President, Ms. Cathy Emanuel, Secretary/Treasurer, Dr. John Peterson, Dr. Lyndon Goodly, Dr. Brent Reifsteck, Dr. Will Sander, and Ms. Beth Vanichtheeranont. Dr. Neil Sharma was absent.

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Approval of Agenda/Addendum

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Dr. Jones made a motion to approve the meeting agenda. Mr. Thies seconded the motion with a modification to move items 4, 5, and 6 under section H to the beginning of the meeting. Dr. Peterson seconded the amended agenda. With all in favor, the motion carried.

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Approval of Minutes

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Dr. Peterson made a motion to approve the August 20, 2024, meeting minutes. Mr. Thies seconded the motion. Ms. Vanichtheeranont and Dr. Sander abstained. With all in favor, the motion carried.

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Dr. Peterson made a motion to approve the Champaign County contract between the Champaign County Public Health Department and IDPH for the Comprehensive Health Protection Grant – FY 2025 in the amount of \$185,200.50 for the time period of June 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025. Mr. Thies seconded the motion. With all in favor, the motion carried. A follow-up presentation regarding the PrEP grant will be held at the next meeting.

Our experienced workforce is adept at caring for school-aged children, ensuring their comfort and providing education to promote good oral health. PHC has made progress in selecting a dental supervisor and eagerly anticipates making a final selection very soon.

Current Staff:

- 2 Dentists at FTE
- 2 Public Health Dental Hygienist FTE
- 3 Expanded Function Dental Assistants FTE
- 3 Dental Assistants FTE

Recruiting

November three Dentist were screened and interviewed, unfortunately no positive results with onboarding for a variety of reasons from potential candidates. The fact remains, recruitment continues to be challenging not just for Champaign and Illinois in general. PHC continues to receive random interested Dentist candidates. My professional opinion, recruitment is challenged by lower-than-average reimbursement rates for dental procedures, thereby reducing interest of private dentist willing and able to see subsidized (Medicaid and Medicare) dental patients. PHC contracted with a recruitment firm experienced in working specifically with FQHC (federally qualified health centers) for dentist effective end of November

Please to report our Dental Hygienist, successfully met and passed the Public Health certification exam in mid-November 2024 and is now one of two PHDH for Promise. We continue to recruit for an additional one or two - PHDH.

Activities

HFS provide the training and oversight for our All-Kids Dental program to become reinstated. Due to staffing – PHC attempted to partner with Head Start to provide a few dental screenings in November, but logistics (holidays) prevented PHC implementation, however December should look much better.

Program Structure

November - PHC set up State Calendar portal to ensure HFS (Health and Family Services) who oversees- the All-Kids Dental program, to be aware of events set up for December 2024. The pedal for one of our portable equipment is still back ordered.

Competencies were administered and completed to all the DA’s and PHDH’s this month. We will be compiling the internal strengths and weaknesses of the team and looking at our opportunities and threats of external influences.

Summary

November was expected to be a challenging month due to having ONE dentist until the first week of December 2024. Despite having limited Dentist, we are pleased to report that we adjusted a few operational steps and were still able to see 303 kids. The success was entirely based on dental team synergy that worked together to see our patients and ensure kids were not left out. In addition, PHC will be reviewing the completed annual dental staff competencies and creating training to enhance care through better trained staff. The end of the year and the year to come looks promising, as we have additional interviews set up for dentists, and a Dentist recruitment firm selected.

PHC contracted with a recruitment firm experienced in working specifically with FQHC (federally qualified health centers) for dentist effective end of November, but we have not seen much movement. Holiday season slows recruitment.

PHC continues to recruit for an additional one or two - PHDH. If anyone knows of a candidate's interest, please do not hesitate to reach out to us.

As part of the All Kids Dental program - HFS provided an on-site audit during our December 4th event in Rantoul and the Head Start site. Overall, a few recommendations, but Dental team passed the onsite audit evaluation. In addition, PHC dental team conducted other Head Start events on December 11th and the 18th.

Equipment

December was a breath of fresh air with both dentists back, but with the holidays, schedules were hit and miss with patients; No Shows or canceling appointments. Despite holiday challenges, we are pleased to report that we were still able to see 400 kids. The end of the year and the year to come looks promising, as we have additional interviews set up for dentists, hygienist, dental assistants, and a Dentist recruitment firm selected.

We anticipate after privileging and credentialing a start date in April / May of 2025. The fact remains, recruitment continues to be challenging not just for Champaign, but Illinois in general. PHC continues to receive random interested Dentist candidates. My professional opinion remains the same, recruitment is challenged due in part to lower-than-average reimbursement rates for dental procedures, thereby reducing interest of private dentist willing and able to see subsidized (Medicaid and Medicare) dental patients. PHC contracted with a recruitment firm experienced in working specifically with FQHC (federally qualified health centers) for dentist effective end of November, but we have not seen much movement. Holiday season showed a improvement in our P/L statement, which is a good sign we are on the right track.

PHC continues to recruit for an additional one or two - PHDH. If anyone knows of a candidate's interest, please do not hesitate to reach out to us.

The pedal for one of our portable equipment units, is still back ordered. We have decided to return it to our inventory and use it as is, while we await the pedal. Staff reported they don't use pedal control anyway

Summary

2025 - January is looking great for dental and our Outreach School aged kids screenings. Holidays are behind us and with a new Dentist on boarding in April / May, allows us time operationally to have his Dental Assistants ready for his arrival. No Shows or canceling appointments continue to challenge our service line. Sad to report this behavior is costly to dental, so mitigating with walkin , EMR (emergency appointments) has become essential. The end of last year was a good one, and the year to come looks promising, as we have additional interviews set up for dentists, hygienist, dental assistants, and a Dentist recruitment firm selected.


