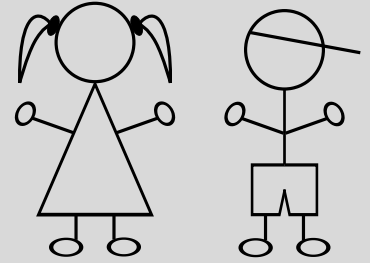

CHAMPAIGN COUNTY MULTIDISCIPLINARY TEAM (MDT):

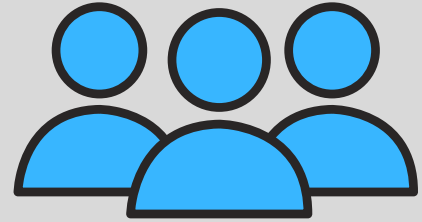
The MDT consists of the Ford and Champaign County States Attorney's Office, CAC staff DCFS, 15 law enforcement agencies, (including the FBI and homeland security), CARLE (medical), and 4 local mental health professionals.

- 10 MDT members attended the CACI Champions of Children's Conference
- Case Review was conducted 12 times with all MDT disciplines
- Champaign County Advisory Board reviewed and adopted an updated Protocol for a coordinated response system in child abuse cases
- 21 MDT members attended "Medical Issues in Child Abuse" training presented by Dr. Buetow
- 6 MDT members attended the "Carle's Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner annual conference"
- 17 MDT Members attended "Medical Neglect in child abuse" training conducted by Dr. Buetow
- All CAC members got vaccinated against COVID-19
