Correspondence and Communications / CUPHD COVID-19 Updates

Ms. Julie Pryde reported that we are in a major surge of COVID-19 cases which goes beyond CUPHD's ability contact trace. Positive cases will receive a message from the State surge center and CUPHD will focus on long-term care facilities, daycares, and schools. Champaign County has had 240 deaths. CUPHD will continue to focus on preventing as much death and hospitalization as possible through vaccination.

Public Participation on Non-Agenda Items

Ms. Sarah Michaels, Director of Environmental Health, addressed the Board sharing that there will be new regulation for cottage food operators allowing them to sell beyond just Farmer's Markets which will include fairs, festivals, and public events. She is recommending to charge the allowed \$50.00 registration fee which would align with the current Farmer's Market fee schedule for those that sell pre-packaged refrigerated items. Cottage food operators will be allowed to prep food in the home that does not require refrigeration. This item will be added to the next meeting agenda.
