MISDEMEANOR SECOND CHANCE PROGRAM AGREEMENT

The People are represented by Assistant State’s Attorney
The Defendant is represented personally and by Counsel
By agreement of the parties, the Defendant now enters into the Misdemeanor Second Chance Program under the terms listed below. While completing the program requirements, the Defendant shall remain released on bond and shall comply with the statutory and judicially imposed terms of said release.

Within 60 days of the entry of this agreement, the Defendant agrees to complete the following:

- 15 hours of public service work under the supervision of the Champaign County Court Services Department.
- Payment to the Champaign County Circuit Clerk’s Office of a fee in the amount of \$ 100.00.
- Payment of full restitution in the amount of \$, said payments to be posted to the Champaign County Circuit Clerk’s Office to be remanded by the Clerk’s Office to the following named victim or victims:

DEFENDANT ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT SHOULD SHE/HE FAIL TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT, THAT UPON A SUBSEQUENT FINDING OF GUILTY, ANY MONEYS PAID IN RESTITUTION WILL BE PAID TO THE NAMED VICTIM ABOVE.

- Completion of the Stoplifting on-line education course through 3rd Millennium Classrooms, including payment of all applicable fees.
- Refrain from possessing or having in his/her body the presence of any alcohol or illicit drug prohibited by the Cannabis Control Act or Controlled Substances Act, or the Methamphetamine Control and Community Protection Act, unless prescribed by a physician.

THE DEFENDANT HAS THE BURDEN OF DEMONSTRATING COMPLIANCE WITH THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT. COMPLIANCE SHALL BE DEMONSTRATED BY A LETTER OF COMPLETION OF PUBLIC SERVICE WORK AND/OR ON-LINE EDUCATION FROM COURT SERVICES FILED IN THE COURT FILE AND THROUGH THE RECORDS OF THE CHAMPAIGN COUNTY CIRCUIT CLERK’S OFFICE.

If the Defendant does not complete the above listed tasks within 60 days of filing this agreement with the Champaign County Circuit, violates the terms and conditions of bond, or violates any criminal statute of any jurisdiction, this agreement shall be terminated unsatisfactorily and, the case shall remain on the misdemeanor pre-trial docket of Judge Brett Olmstead.

Upon successful completion of the above terms, and if Defendant complies fully with the statutory or judicially imposed conditions of bail, the State agrees to move to dismiss all charges in this case.
